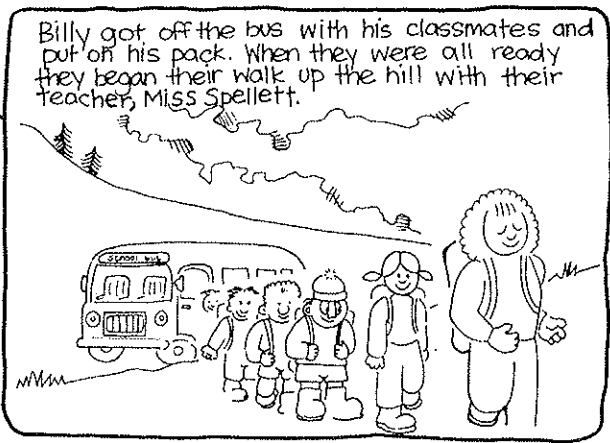
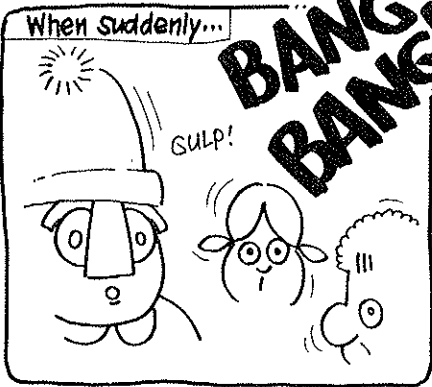


# BILLY HOOK

Excuse me sir, did you know we were here before you fired your gun?



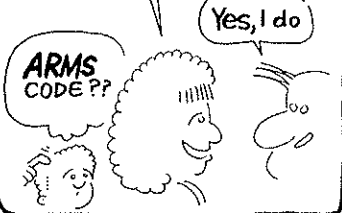
Yes, I always check before I shoot. I saw you all coming up the hill....



... and I was shooting in the other direction - away from you!



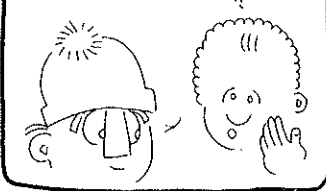
That's good. You must know your Arms Code very well

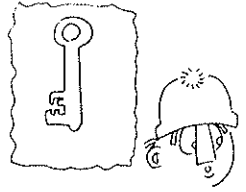
What's the ARMS CODE?



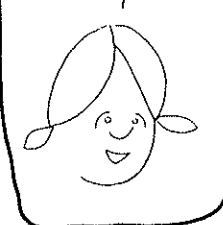
The Arms Code is a book that tells you all about guns, like how to always 'point them in a safe direction...



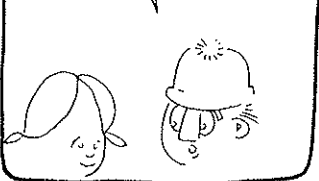
...and how they should always be locked away when they're not being used.

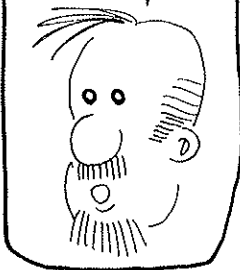
Who knows what the ARMS CODE IS?

It's the rule book about firearms.

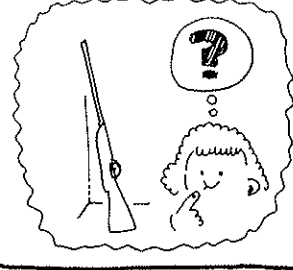
Tell the class what the most important rule is, Billy.



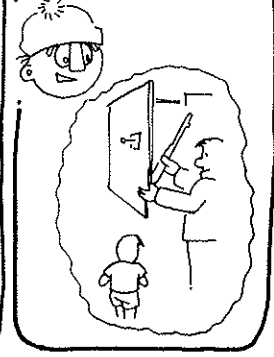
"Never touch or play with firearms or bullets!"



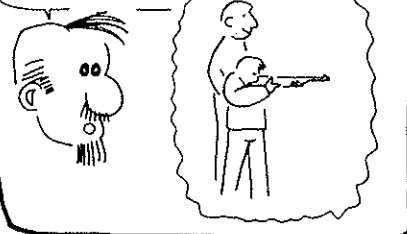
That's right! But what should you do if you find a firearm or some ammunition lying around?

But! until then please remember...



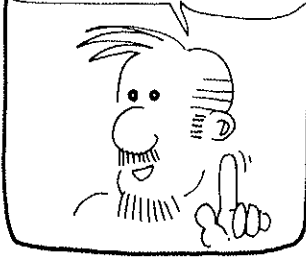
"...-firearms are not toys!"



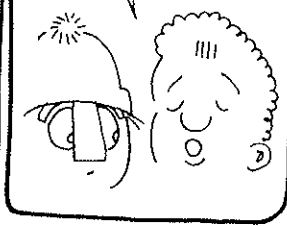

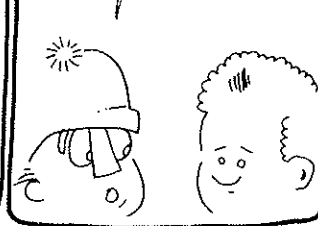
-Go and tell an adult  
-They'll know what to do!



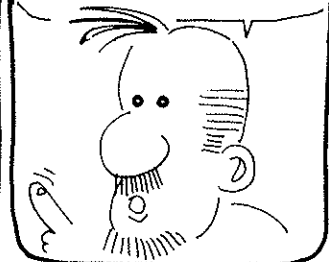
But we don't want to be called 'TELL-TALES', Mr Cutter!



You're not telling tales if someone's life is in danger!



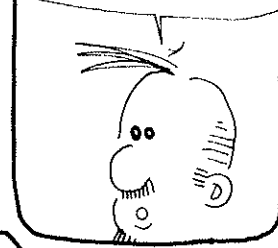
That's right! We must all try to help keep people safe!



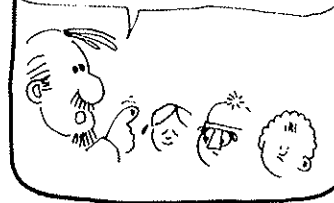
Mr Cutter, On T.V, people point guns and shoot each other all the time!



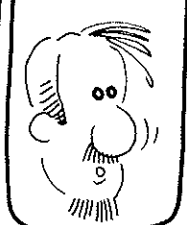

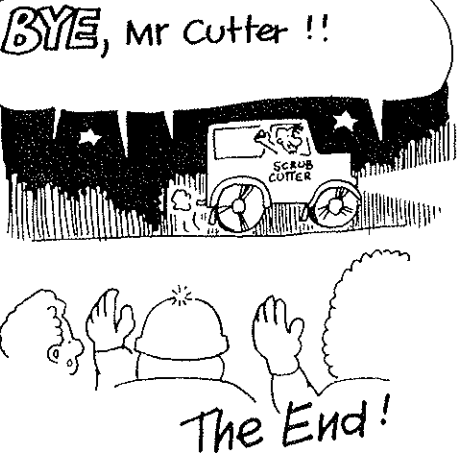
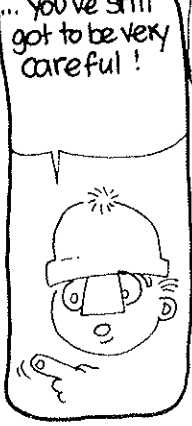
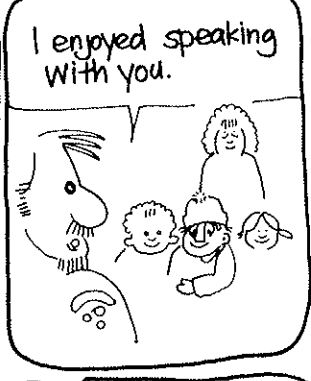
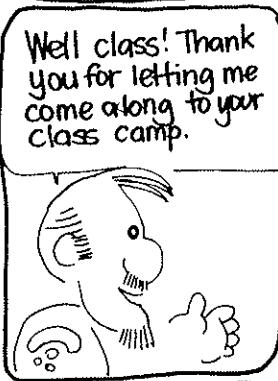
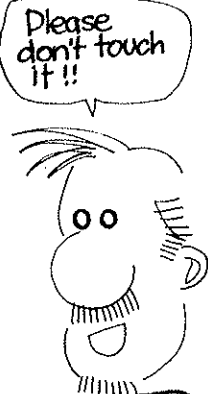
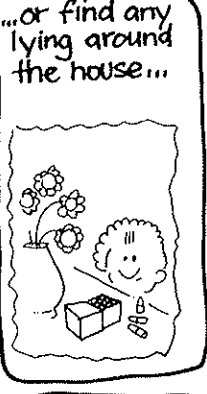
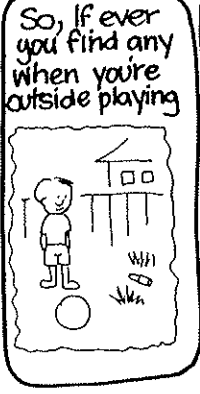
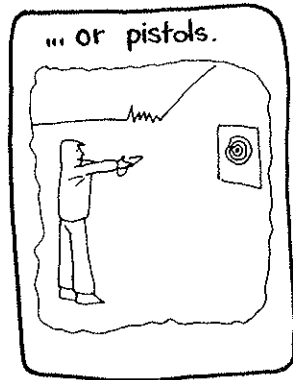
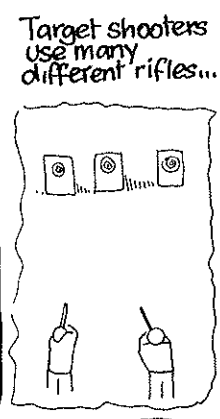
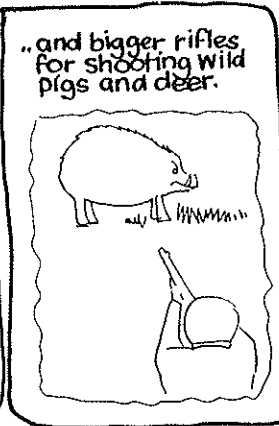
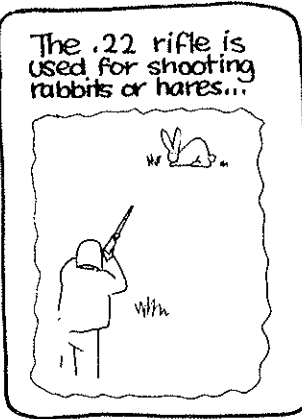
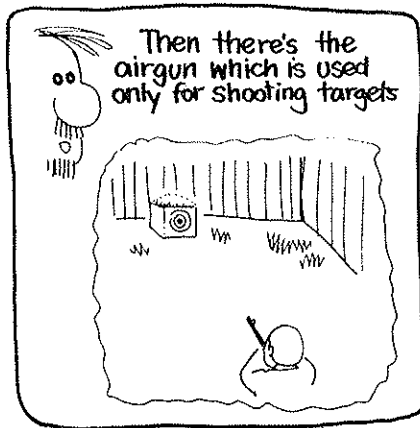


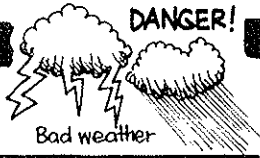
Good question! Shotguns are used mainly for shooting ducks...



...or for clay shooting. This means shooting clay discs that are thrown into the air by a machine.





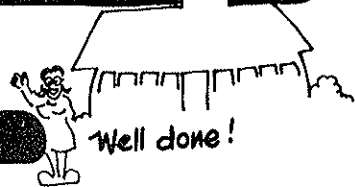
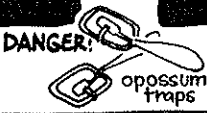
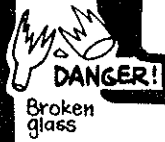
